Q1. Who asked Jesus, 'Who is my neighbour?'

Answer: A. A certain lawyer

And, behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and tempted him, saying, Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? (Luke 10:25) (Luke 10:25, KJV)

Q2. What two things did Jesus say doing leads to eternal life?

Answer: A. Loving the LORD with all thy heart, soul, strength, and mind; and thy neighbour as thyself

Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself. (Luke 10:27) (Luke 10:27, KJV)

Q3. Where was the man going when he fell among thieves?

Answer: A. From Jerusalem to Jericho

A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves. (Luke 10:30) (Luke 10:30, KJV)

Q4. What did the thieves do to the man?

Answer: A. Stripped him, wounded him, and departed leaving him half dead

Which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. (Luke 10:30) (Luke 10:30, KJV)

Q5. Which two religious leaders passed by on the other side?

Answer: A. A priest and a Levite

And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side. (Luke 10:31-32) (Luke 10:31, KJV)

Q6. Who stopped to help the wounded man?

Answer: A. A Samaritan

But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him. (Luke 10:33) (Luke 10:33, KJV)

Q7. What did the Samaritan first do for the man's wounds?

Answer: A. Bound them up, pouring in oil and wine

And went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. (Luke 10:34) (Luke 10:34, KJV)

Q8. Where did the Samaritan take the wounded man?

Answer: A. To an inn

And brought him to an inn, and took care of him. (Luke 10:34) (Luke 10:34, KJV)

Q9. How much money did the Samaritan give the innkeeper?

Answer: A. Two pence

And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee. (Luke 10:35) (Luke 10:35, KJV)

Q10. What did Jesus tell the lawyer to go and do?

Answer: A. Go, and do thou likewise

Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise. (Luke 10:37) (Luke 10:37, KJV)
