Q1. What does the thief do?

Answer: A. The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. (John 10:10) (John 10:10, KJV)

Q2. Who did Jesus say He was?

Answer: A. I am the good shepherd

I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. (John 10:11) (John 10:11, KJV)

Q3. What does the good shepherd do for the sheep?

Answer: A. Giveth his life

I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. (John 10:11) (John 10:11, KJV)

Q4. What does the hireling do when he sees the wolf?

Answer: A. Leaveth the sheep, and fleeth

But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth. (John 10:12) (John 10:12, KJV)
