And when one of them that sat at meat with him heard these things, he said unto him, Blessed is he that shall eat bread in the kingdom of God. (Luke 14:15) (Luke 14:15, KJV)

**Q2. What did the man prepare?**

**Answer:** A. A great supper

Then said he unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many. (Luke 14:16) (Luke 14:16, KJV)

**Q3. What did the first guest excuse himself with?**

**Answer:** A. I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it

The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused. (Luke 14:18) (Luke 14:18, KJV)

**Q4. What did the second guest say?**

**Answer:** A. I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them

And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused. (Luke 14:19) (Luke 14:19, KJV)
