Q1. What is the kingdom of heaven likened unto?

Answer: B. Treasure hid in a field

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field. (Matthew 13:44) (Matthew 13:44, KJV)

Q2. What did the man do when he found the treasure?

Answer: C. Sold all that he had, and bought that field

The which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field. (Matthew 13:44) (Matthew 13:44, KJV)

Q3. Why did the man hide the treasure again?

Answer: B. For joy, before buying the field

He hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath. (Matthew 13:44) (Matthew 13:44, KJV)

Q4. What did the man sell?

Answer: B. All that he had

Selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field. (Matthew 13:44) (Matthew 13:44, KJV)

Q5. What does the treasure represent?

Answer: A. The kingdom of heaven

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field. (Matthew 13:44) (Matthew 13:44, KJV)

Q6. What must one do to obtain the kingdom?

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a merchant man, seeking goodly pearls. (Matthew 13:45) (Matthew 13:45, KJV)

Q10. What does Jesus say the kingdom of heaven is worth?

Answer: A. More than all our possessions

The man selleth all that he hath to obtain it, showing its supreme value. (Matthew 13:44) (Matthew 13:44, KJV)
