Q1. What went forth in the parable?

Answer: B. A sower

Behold, a sower went forth to sow. (Matthew 13:3, KJV)

Q2. What happened to the seed by the way side?

Answer: B. The fowls devoured it

The fowls came and devoured them up. (Matthew 13:4, KJV)

Q3. Why did the seed on stony places spring up quickly?

Answer: B. It had no deepness of earth

Because they had no deepness of earth. (Matthew 13:5, KJV)

Q4. What scorched the seed on stony ground?

Answer: C. The sun

When the sun was up, they were scorched. (Matthew 13:6, KJV)

Q5. What choked the seed among thorns?

Answer: B. The thorns sprang up

The thorns sprung up, and choked them. (Matthew 13:7, KJV)

Q6. What does the seed represent?

Answer: B. The word of God

Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. (Luke 8:11, KJV)

Q7. Who takes away the seed sown by the way side?

Answer: B. The wicked one

Then cometh the wicked one, and catcheth away that which was sown. (Matthew 13:19, KJV)

Q8. What chokes the seed sown among thorns?

Answer: B. The care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches

The care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word. (Matthew 13:22, KJV)

Q9. What yields did the good ground bring forth?

Answer: B. Some thirty, some sixty, some an hundredfold

Some an hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold. (Matthew 13:23, KJV)

Q10. Why did Jesus speak to the multitude in parables?

Because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not. (Matthew 13:13, KJV)
