Sold all that he had, and bought it. (Matthew 13:46, KJV)

Q4. What parable comes just before this one?

Answer: B. The Hidden Treasure

The kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field. (Matthew 13:44, KJV)

Q5. What did the man find hidden in the field?

Answer: C. A treasure

The which when a man hath found, he hideth. (Matthew 13:44, KJV)
