Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. When did the friend come asking for bread?

Answer: B. At midnight

Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves. (Luke 11:5) (Luke 11:5, KJV)

Q2. Why did the friend need bread?

Answer: A. For a friend of his had come from a journey, and he had nothing to set before him

For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him? (Luke 11:6) (Luke 11:6, KJV)

Q3. What was the friend's response from within?

Answer: A. Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed

And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee. (Luke 11:7) (Luke 11:7, KJV)

Q4. Why will the friend rise and give bread?

Answer: A. Because of his importunity

I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity he will rise and give him as many as he needeth. (Luke 11:8) (Luke 11:8, KJV)

Q5. What does Jesus say to ask for?

And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. (Luke 11:9) (Luke 11:9, KJV)
