When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory. (Matthew 25:31) (Matthew 25:31, KJV)

Q2. What shall He do before Him?

Answer: A. Gather all nations, and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats

And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats. (Matthew 25:32) (Matthew 25:32, KJV)

Q3. Where shall He set the sheep?

Answer: A. On his right hand

And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. (Matthew 25:33) (Matthew 25:33, KJV)

Q4. What did the King say to those on His right hand?

Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink? (Matthew 25:37) (Matthew 25:37, KJV)

Q7. What did the King say He counted as done to Himself?

Answer: A. Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me

And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me. (Matthew 25:40) (Matthew 25:40, KJV)

Q8. What did the King say to those on the left hand?

Answer: A. Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels

Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels. (Matthew 25:41) (Matthew 25:41, KJV)

Q9. Why were the goats condemned?

Answer: A. For I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me no drink

(Matthew 25:42, KJV)

Q10. Where do the righteous go?

And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal. (Matthew 25:46) (Matthew 25:46, KJV)
