## Answer Key & Explanations

### Q1. What was the steward accused of?

**Answer:** A. Wasting his lord's goods

There was a certain rich man, which had a steward; and the same was accused unto him that he had wasted his goods. (Luke 16:1) (Luke 16:1, KJV)

### Q2. What did the lord tell the steward?

**Answer:** A. Give an account of thy stewardship; for thou mayest be no longer steward

And he called him, and said unto him, How is it that I hear this of thee? give an account of thy stewardship; for thou mayest be no longer steward. (Luke 16:2) (Luke 16:2, KJV)

### Q3. What did the steward reason within himself?

**Answer:** A. I cannot dig; to beg I am ashamed

Then the steward said within himself, What shall I do? for my lord taketh away from me the stewardship: I cannot dig; to beg I am ashamed. (Luke 16:3) (Luke 16:3, KJV)

### Q4. What did the steward do to secure his future?

**Answer:** A. Called his lord's debtors and reduced their bills

So he called every one of his lord's debtors unto him, and said unto the first, How much owest thou unto my lord? And he said, An hundred measures of oil. And he said unto him, Take thy bill, and sit down quickly, and write fifty. (Luke 16:5-6) (Luke 16:5, KJV)

### Q5. What did the lord commend the unjust steward for?

### Q7. What does Jesus say about faithfulness in little?
