Q1. Who asked Jesus how often to forgive?

Answer: B. Peter

Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me? (Matthew 18:21, KJV)

Q2. How many times did Peter suggest?

Answer: C. Seven

Till seven times? (Matthew 18:21, KJV)

Q3. How did Jesus answer?

Answer: B. Until seventy times seven

Until seventy times seven. (Matthew 18:22, KJV)

Q4. To whom is the kingdom likened in this parable?

Answer: B. A certain king

A certain king, which would take account of his servants. (Matthew 18:23, KJV)

Q5. How much did the first servant owe?

Answer: C. Ten thousand talents

One was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents. (Matthew 18:24, KJV)

Q6. What did the king first command?

Answer: B. He and his family be sold

His lord commanded him to be sold, and his wife, and children. (Matthew 18:25, KJV)

Q7. What did the king do when the servant fell down and worshipped him?

Answer: B. Loosed him, and forgave him the debt

The lord of that servant... loosed him, and forgave him the debt. (Matthew 18:27, KJV)

Q8. How much did his fellowservant owe him?

Answer: A. A hundred pence

Which owed him an hundred pence. (Matthew 18:28, KJV)

Q9. What did the unmerciful servant do?

Answer: B. Took him by the throat

He... took him by the throat, saying, Pay me that thou owest. (Matthew 18:28, KJV)

Q10. To whom did the king deliver the wicked servant?

Answer: B. The tormentors

Delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due. (Matthew 18:34, KJV)
