## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1.** Paul and Timothy identify themselves at the beginning of the epistle as the what of Jesus Christ?

**Answer:** B. Servants

Paul and Timotheus call themselves 'the servants of Jesus Christ'. (Philippians 1:1, KJV)

**Q2.** Paul expresses confidence that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until when?

**Answer:** A. The day of Jesus Christ

God is faithful to perform His work until 'the day of Jesus Christ'. (Philippians 1:6, KJV)

**Q3.** Complete the verse: 'For to me to live is Christ, and to die is \_\_\_\_.'

**Answer:** C. Gain

Paul declares that for the believer, death is 'gain'. (Philippians 1:21, KJV)

**Q4.** According to chapter 2, what mind should be in the believer?

**Answer:** C. The mind of Christ Jesus

Paul exhorts, 'Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus'. (Philippians 2:5, KJV)

**Q5.** At the name of Jesus, Paul says that every what should bow?

**Answer:** C. Knee

The scripture states 'at the name of Jesus every knee should bow'. (Philippians 2:10, KJV)

**Q6.** Which fellow-soldier did Paul send back to the Philippians because he had been sick nigh unto death?

**Answer:** A. Epaphroditus

Epaphroditus was Paul's messenger who longed for the Philippians after his illness. (Philippians 2:25, KJV)

**Q7.** Of which tribe of Israel was Paul a member?

**Answer:** C. Benjamin

Paul describes his heritage as being 'of the tribe of Benjamin'. (Philippians 3:5, KJV)

**Q8.** Paul says he counts all things but loss for what reason?

**Answer:** B. The excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus

He counts all as dung for the 'excellency of the knowledge of Christ'. (Philippians 3:8, KJV)

**Q9.** What does Paul say he can do through Christ which strengtheneth him?

**Answer:** A. All things

Paul famously writes, 'I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me'. (Philippians 4:13, KJV)

**Q10.** Those of whose household send greetings to the Philippians at the end of the letter?

**Answer:** B. Caesar's

Paul includes greetings from 'they that are of Caesar's household'. (Philippians 4:22, KJV)
