Q1. Whose son was Phinehas?

Answer: B. Eleazar

Numbers 25:7 (KJV) — 'Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest.' (Numbers 25:7, KJV)

Q2. What did Phinehas take in his hand?

Answer: B. A javelin

Numbers 25:7 (KJV) — 'took a javelin in his hand.' (Numbers 25:7, KJV)

Q3. Whom did he slay?

Answer: B. An Israelite man and a Midianitish woman

Numbers 25:8 (KJV) — 'thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman.' (Numbers 25:8, KJV)

Q4. What did Phinehas's act turn away?

Answer: A. The plague

Numbers 25:8 (KJV) — 'So the plague was stayed.' (Numbers 25:8, KJV)

Q5. How many died in that plague?

Answer: C. 24,000

Numbers 25:9 (KJV) — 'those that died in the plague were twenty and four thousand.' (Numbers 25:9, KJV)

Q6. What covenant did God give Phinehas?

Answer: B. Of an everlasting priesthood

Numbers 25:13 (KJV) — 'the covenant of an everlasting priesthood.' (Numbers 25:13, KJV)

Q7. What was Phinehas zealous for?

Answer: B. His God

Numbers 25:13 (KJV) — 'he was zealous for his God.' (Numbers 25:13, KJV)

Q8. Phinehas's act was counted to him for what?

Answer: B. Righteousness

Psalms 106:31 (KJV) — 'that was counted unto him for righteousness.' (Psalms 106:31, KJV)

Q9. Phinehas later led Israel in war against which nation?

Answer: B. Midian

Numbers 31:6 (KJV) — Moses sent Phinehas with the holy instruments against Midian. (Numbers 31:6, KJV)

Q10. In Joshua 22, Phinehas was sent to which tribes about an altar?

Answer: B. Reuben, Gad, and half of Manasseh

Joshua 22:13 (KJV) — sent unto the children of Reuben, Gad, and the half tribe of Manasseh. (Joshua 22:13, KJV)
