Q1. In what epistle is Phoebe commended?

Answer: A. Romans

Romans 16:1 (KJV) — 'I commend unto you Phebe our sister.' (Romans 16:1, KJV)

Q2. Of what church was Phoebe a servant?

Answer: C. Cenchrea

Romans 16:1 (KJV) — 'a servant of the church which is at Cenchrea.' (Romans 16:1, KJV)

Q3. What does Paul call her?

Answer: B. Sister

Romans 16:1 (KJV) — 'Phebe our sister.' (Romans 16:1, KJV)

Q4. How are the saints to receive her?

Answer: A. In the Lord

Romans 16:2 (KJV) — 'receive her in the Lord, as becometh saints.' (Romans 16:2, KJV)

Q5. Why are they to assist her?

Answer: B. She has been a succourer of many, and of Paul also

Romans 16:2 (KJV) — 'she hath been a succourer of many, and of myself also.' (Romans 16:2, KJV)

Q6. What kind of business did Phoebe have need of?

Answer: B. Whatsoever business she hath need of

Romans 16:2 (KJV). (Romans 16:2, KJV)

Q7. Cenchrea was the port of which city?

Answer: B. Corinth

Cenchrea was the eastern port of Corinth (cf. Acts 18:18). (Acts 18:18, KJV)

Q8. Paul says she has been a 'succourer of many' — meaning what?

Answer: B. A helper / patroness

Romans 16:2 (KJV) — the word denotes a helper or patroness. (Romans 16:2, KJV)

Q9. Phoebe is named alongside greetings sent to which city's church?

Answer: A. Rome

Romans 16 (KJV) is sent to the saints at Rome. (Romans 16:1, KJV)

Q10. Who wrote the commendation of Phoebe?

Answer: B. Paul

Romans 1:1 (KJV) — 'Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ.' (Romans 1:1, KJV)
