**Q2.** What did Jesus tell the Samaritan woman about worship?

**Answer:** A. The hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth  
But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. (John 4:23, KJV)

**Q3.** What kind of worshippers does the Father seek?

**Answer:** B. Those who worship Him in spirit and in truth  
God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. (John 4:24, KJV)

**Q4.** What does Hebrews 13:15 call a sacrifice of praise?

By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. (Hebrews 13:15, KJV)

And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come. (Revelation 4:8, KJV)
