Q1. Why did the Queen of Sheba come to Solomon?

Answer: B. To prove him with hard questions

1 Kings 10:1 (KJV) — She 'came to prove him with hard questions.' (1 Kings 10:1, KJV)

Q2. What did she hear concerning Solomon?

Answer: B. His fame concerning the name of the LORD

1 Kings 10:1 (KJV) — 'When the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD.' (1 Kings 10:1, KJV)

Q3. Did Solomon answer all her questions?

Answer: B. All of them; nothing was hid

1 Kings 10:3 (KJV) — 'Solomon told her all her questions: there was not any thing hid.' (1 Kings 10:3, KJV)

Q4. What was her reaction when she saw Solomon's wisdom and house?

Answer: A. There was no more spirit in her

1 Kings 10:5 (KJV) — 'There was no more spirit in her.' (1 Kings 10:5, KJV)

Q5. How much gold did she give Solomon?

Answer: C. 120 talents

1 Kings 10:10 (KJV) — 'She gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold.' (1 Kings 10:10, KJV)

Q6. What spice was given to Solomon in unmatched abundance?

Answer: B. Spices

1 Kings 10:10 (KJV) — 'There came no more such abundance of spices.' (1 Kings 10:10, KJV)

Q7. What had been told her in her own land regarding Solomon's wisdom?

Answer: B. Not the half

1 Kings 10:7 (KJV) — 'The half was not told me.' (1 Kings 10:7, KJV)

Q8. Whom did the queen bless?

Answer: B. The LORD God of Israel

1 Kings 10:9 (KJV) — 'Blessed be the LORD thy God, which delighted in thee.' (1 Kings 10:9, KJV)

Q9. Where did Jesus say she would rise up in judgment with?

Answer: A. This generation

Matthew 12:42 (KJV) — 'The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with this generation.' (Matthew 12:42, KJV)

Q10. From what far place did Jesus say she came?
