Q1. In which city did Rahab live?

Answer: B. Jericho

And Joshua the son of Nun sent out of Shittim two men to spy secretly, saying, Go view the land, even Jericho. And they went, and came into an harlot's house, named Rahab, and lodged there. (Joshua 2:1, KJV)

Q2. What was Rahab's profession before she believed?

Answer: B. A harlot

And they went, and came into an harlot's house, named Rahab, and lodged there. (Joshua 2:1, KJV)

Q3. What did Rahab hide on her roof?

Answer: A. The spies of Israel

But she had brought them up to the roof of the house, and hid them with the stalks of flax. (Joshua 2:6, KJV)

Q4. What sign did Rahab hang from her window for protection?
