Q1. In Israel, what did a kinsman redeemer do for a poor relative?

Answer: B. Redeemed land, freedom, or family lineage

Leviticus 25:25 (KJV) — 'If thy brother be waxen poor, and hath sold away some of his possession, and if any of his kin come to redeem it, then shall he redeem that which his brother sold.' (Leviticus 25:25, KJV)

Q2. Who was the famous kinsman redeemer in the book of Ruth?

Answer: B. Boaz

Ruth 3:9 (KJV) — Ruth said to Boaz, 'Spread therefore thy skirt over thine handmaid; for thou art a near kinsman.'
Ruth 4 shows Boaz redeeming Ruth. (Ruth 3:9, KJV)

Q3. What did God use to redeem Israel from Egypt?

Answer: A. A mighty hand and an outstretched arm

Deuteronomy 7:8 (KJV) — 'The LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.' (Deuteronomy 7:8, KJV)

Q4. What did Jesus say He came to give His life as?

Answer: B. A ransom for many

Mark 10:45 (KJV) — 'For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.' (Mark 10:45, KJV)

Q5. In whom do we have redemption through His blood?

Answer: B. Jesus Christ

Ephesians 1:7 (KJV) — 'In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace.' (Ephesians 1:7, KJV)

Q6. What were believers redeemed from, according to Galatians 3:13?

Answer: A. From the curse of the law

Galatians 3:13 (KJV) — 'Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.' (Galatians 3:13, KJV)

Q7. What price were believers NOT redeemed with?

Answer: A. Gold and silver

1 Peter 1:18-19 (KJV) — 'Ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold... But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.' (1 Peter 1:18, KJV)

Q8. What does redemption include, according to Romans 8:23?

Answer: A. The redemption of our body

Romans 8:23 (KJV) — 'And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body.' (Romans 8:23, KJV)

Q9. What day was known as the Day of Redemption?

Answer: C. The Jubilee, when every man returned to his possession

Leviticus 25:28 (KJV) — In the year of jubilee, land returned to its original owners; Leviticus 25:54 speaks of redemption from slavery. The jubilee was the great year of redemption. (Leviticus 25:28, KJV)

Q10. Who is called 'the Redeemer' in Job?

Answer: B. God / the LORD

Job 19:25 (KJV) — 'For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth.'
(Job 19:25, KJV)
