Q1. Who was Rehoboam's father?

Answer: B. Solomon

1 Kings 11:43 (KJV) — 'Rehoboam his son reigned in his stead.' (1 Kings 11:43, KJV)

Q2. Where did all Israel come to make Rehoboam king?

Answer: B. Shechem

1 Kings 12:1 (KJV) — 'Rehoboam went to Shechem: for all Israel were come to Shechem to make him king.' (1 Kings 12:1, KJV)

Q3. Whose counsel did Rehoboam forsake?

Answer: B. The old men

1 Kings 12:8 (KJV) — 'He forsook the counsel of the old men.' (1 Kings 12:8, KJV)

Q4. What did Rehoboam threaten with regarding chastising the people?

Answer: B. Whips replaced by scorpions

1 Kings 12:11 (KJV) — 'My father hath chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.' (1 Kings 12:11, KJV)

Q5. How many tribes remained loyal to Rehoboam?

Answer: B. Two (Judah and Benjamin)

1 Kings 12:21 (KJV) — He assembled 'the house of Judah, with the tribe of Benjamin.' (1 Kings 12:21, KJV)

Q6. Who became king over the ten tribes that revolted?

Answer: A. Jeroboam

1 Kings 12:20 (KJV) — 'They sent and called him unto the congregation, and made him king over all Israel.' (1 Kings 12:20, KJV)

Q7. Which Egyptian king came up against Jerusalem in Rehoboam's fifth year?

Answer: B. Shishak

1 Kings 14:25 (KJV) — 'Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem.' (1 Kings 14:25, KJV)

Q8. What did Shishak take from the temple?

Answer: B. The treasures and shields of gold

1 Kings 14:26 (KJV) — He 'took away the treasures of the house of the LORD... and the shields of gold.' (1 Kings 14:26, KJV)

Q9. With what did Rehoboam replace the gold shields?

Answer: B. Brass shields

1 Kings 14:27 (KJV) — 'King Rehoboam made in their stead brasen shields.' (1 Kings 14:27, KJV)

Q10. How old was Rehoboam when he began to reign?

Answer: A. Forty-one

1 Kings 14:21 (KJV) — 'Rehoboam was forty and one years old when he began to reign.' (1 Kings 14:21, KJV)
