Q1. Where was Ruth from originally?

Answer: B. Moab

And Ruth the Moabitess said unto Naomi, Intreat me not to leave thee, or to return from following after thee. (Ruth 1:16, KJV)

Q2. What famous words did Ruth speak to Naomi?

Answer: A. Whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge

And Ruth said, Intreat me not to leave thee, or to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people, and thy God my God. (Ruth 1:16, KJV)

Q3. Whose fields did Ruth glean in?

Answer: B. Boaz's, a mighty man of wealth

And Naomi had a kinsman of her husband's, a mighty man of wealth, of the family of Elimelech; and his name was Boaz. And Ruth the Moabitess said unto Naomi, Let me now go to the field, and glean ears of corn after him in whose sight I shall find grace. (Ruth 2:1, KJV)

Q4. What did Boaz tell his young men concerning Ruth?

Answer: A. Let her glean even among the sheaves, and reproach her not

And when she was risen up to glean, Boaz commanded his young men, saying, Let her glean even among the sheaves, and reproach her not: And let fall also some of the handfuls of purpose for her, and leave them, that she may glean them, and rebuke her not. (Ruth 2:15, KJV)

Q5. What did Naomi instruct Ruth to do at the threshingfloor?

Answer: A. Wait until Boaz had eaten and drunk, then go and lie at his feet

And she went down unto the floor, and did according to all that her mother in law bade her. And when Boaz had eaten and drunk, and his heart was merry, he went to lie down at the end of the heap of corn: and she came softly, and uncovered his feet, and laid her down. (Ruth 3:6, KJV)

Q6. What did Ruth ask Boaz to do?

Answer: A. Spread thy skirt over thine handmaid; for thou art a near kinsman

And she said, I pray thee, let me find grace in thy sight, my lord; for that thou hast comforted me, and for that thou hast spoken friendly unto thine handmaid, though I be not like unto one of thine handmaidens. And he said, Blessed be thou of the LORD, my daughter: for thou hast shewed more kindness in the latter end than at the beginning, inasmuch as thou followedst not young men, whether poor or rich. (Ruth 3:10, KJV)

Q7. What did Boaz do to become Ruth's redeemer?

Answer: A. He purchased all that was Elimelech's and took Ruth to wife

Moreover Ruth the Moabitess, the wife of Mahlon, have I purchased to be my wife, to raise up the name of the dead upon his inheritance, that the name of the dead be not cut off from among his brethren, and from the gate of his place: ye are witnesses this day. (Ruth 4:10, KJV)

Q8. What did the women say about Ruth?

Answer: A. Thy daughter in law, which loveth thee, which is better to thee than seven sons

And the women said unto Naomi, Blessed be the LORD, which hath not left thee this day without a kinsman, that his name may be famous in Israel. And he shall be unto thee a restorer of thy life, and a nourisher of thine old age: for thy daughter in law, which loveth thee, which is better to thee than seven sons, hath born him. (Ruth 4:14, KJV)

Q9. What was the name of Ruth's son?

Answer: B. Obed

And Naomi took the child, and laid it in her bosom, and became nurse unto it. And the women her neighbours gave it a name, saying, There is a son born to Naomi; and they called his name Obed. (Ruth 4:16, KJV)

Q10. Whose ancestor was Ruth's son Obed?

Answer: B. David

And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat David. Ruth's faithfulness placed her in the direct lineage of King David and of the Lord Jesus Christ. (Ruth 4:22, KJV)
