Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. What was Sarah's original name?

Answer: A. Sarai

And Abram and Nahor took them wives: the name of Abram's wife was Sarai. (Genesis 11:29) (Genesis 11:29, KJV)

Q2. What did Sarai mean Sarah would mean?

Answer: A. Princess

As for Sarai thy wife, thou shalt not call her name Sarai, but Sarah shall her name be. (Genesis 17:15) — Sarah means 'princess' or 'noblewoman'. (Genesis 17:15, KJV)

Q3. Why did Sarah laugh when she heard she would have a son?

Answer: A. Because she was old, and well stricken in age; it had ceased to be with her after the manner of women

Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also? (Genesis 18:12) (Genesis 18:12, KJV)

Q4. What did the LORD say about Sarah's laugh?

Answer: A. Is any thing too hard for the LORD?

And the LORD said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old? Is any thing too hard for the LORD? (Genesis 18:13-14) (Genesis 18:13, KJV)

Q5. What did Sarah name her son, and why?

Answer: A. Isaac, because she said, God hath made me to laugh, so that all that hear will laugh with me

And Sarah said, God hath made me to laugh, so that all that hear will laugh with me... and she called his name Isaac. (Genesis 21:6-7) (Genesis 21:6, KJV)

Q6. How old was Sarah when Isaac was born?

Answer: A. Ninety years old

Now Abraham was an hundred years old, when his son Isaac was born unto him. And Sarah said, God hath made me to laugh... (Genesis 21:5-6) — Sarah was ten years younger than Abraham, making her ninety. (Genesis 17:17, 17:24) (Genesis 21:5, KJV)

Q7. What did Sarah ask Abraham to do about Hagar and Ishmael?

Answer: A. Cast out this bondwoman and her son: for the son of this bondwoman shall not be heir with my son, even with Isaac

Wherefore she said unto Abraham, Cast out this bondwoman and her son: for the son of this bondwoman shall not be heir with my son, even with Isaac. (Genesis 21:10) (Genesis 21:10, KJV)

Q8. Where did Sarah die?

Answer: A. Kirjatharba, which is Hebron, in the land of Canaan

And Sarah was an hundred and seven and twenty years old: these were the years of the life of Sarah. And Sarah died in Kirjatharba; the same is Hebron in the land of Canaan. (Genesis 23:1-2) (Genesis 23:1, KJV)

Q9. How old was Sarah when she died?

Answer: A. One hundred and twenty-seven years old

And Sarah was an hundred and seven and twenty years old: these were the years of the life of Sarah. (Genesis 23:1) (Genesis 23:1, KJV)

Q10. Where was Sarah buried?

Answer: A. In the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre

And after this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre: the same is Hebron in the land of Canaan. (Genesis 23:19) (Genesis 23:19, KJV)
