Q1. Who is called the prince of the power of the air?

Answer: B. The devil / Satan

Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience. (Ephesians 2:2, KJV)

Q2. What does James 4:7 tell us to do to the devil?

Answer: B. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you

Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. (James 4:7, KJV)

Q3. How does 1 Peter 5:8 describe the devil?

Answer: A. As a roaring lion, walking about, seeking whom he may devour

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour. (1 Peter 5:8, KJV)

Q4. What are we told not to be ignorant of?

Answer: A. Satan's devices

Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices. (2 Corinthians 2:11, KJV)

Q5. What should we put on to stand against the wiles of the devil?

Answer: B. The whole armour of God

Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. (Ephesians 6:11, KJV)

Q6. What is the sword of the Spirit?

Answer: B. The word of God

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. (Ephesians 6:17, KJV)

Q7. What did Jesus say He saw Satan fall as?

Answer: B. Lightning from heaven

And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. (Luke 10:18, KJV)

Q8. What did Jesus tell Peter that Satan desired to do?

Answer: B. Sift him as wheat

And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat. (Luke 22:31, KJV)

Q9. What does 1 John 4:4 say about the one in us versus the one in the world?

Answer: B. He that is in you is greater than he that is in the world

Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. (1 John 4:4, KJV)

Q10. Who helps us in our infirmities when we know not what to pray?

Answer: B. The Holy Ghost / Spirit

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. (Romans 8:26, KJV)
