Q1. What was Stephen appointed to do in the early church?

Answer: B. Serve tables and oversee the daily ministrations

Look ye out among you seven men... whom we may appoint over this business... And they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost. (Acts 6:3, KJV)

Q2. How is Stephen described before his appointment?

Answer: A. A man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost

A man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost. (Acts 6:5, KJV)

Q3. What did Stephen do among the people?

Answer: A. Great wonders and miracles among the people

And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people. (Acts 6:8, KJV)

Q4. Who disputed with Stephen but could not resist the wisdom and spirit by which he spake?

Answer: B. Certain of the synagogue, Cyrenians, Alexandrians, Cilicians, and them of Asia

Then there arose certain of the synagogue, which is called the synagogue of the Libertines, and Cyrenians, and Alexandrians, and of them of Cilicia and of Asia, disputing with Stephen. And they were not able to resist the wisdom and the spirit by which he spake. (Acts 6:9, KJV)

Q5. What false witnesses said about Stephen?

This man ceaseth not to speak blasphemous words against this holy place, and the law: For we have heard him say, that this Jesus of Nazareth shall destroy this place, and shall change the customs which Moses delivered us. (Acts 6:13, KJV)

Q6. In his speech, whom did Stephen say built the tabernacle?

Answer: B. Moses, according to the fashion he had seen

Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the wilderness, as he had appointed, speaking unto Moses, that he should make it according to the fashion that he had seen. (Acts 7:44, KJV)

Q7. What did Stephen see when he looked up stedfastly into heaven?

Answer: B. The glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God

But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God. (Acts 7:55, KJV)

Q8. What did Stephen say he saw Jesus doing?

Answer: B. Standing on the right hand of God

Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God. (Acts 7:56, KJV)

Q9. What did Stephen do as he was being stoned?

Answer: B. Cried with a loud voice, 'Lord, lay not this sin to their charge'

And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep. (Acts 7:60, KJV)

Q10. Who stood by, consenting unto Stephen's death, and kept the raiment of them that slew him?

Answer: B. Paul / Saul of Tarsus

And the witnesses laid down their clothes at a young man's feet, whose name was Saul. And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit. (Acts 7:58, KJV)
