Q1. What did Jesus say about serving two masters?

Answer: B. Ye cannot serve God and mammon

No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. (Matthew 6:24, KJV)

Q2. What did the rich young ruler do when Jesus asked him to sell his possessions?

Answer: B. He went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions

But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions. (Matthew 19:22, KJV)

Q3. What did the poor widow cast into the treasury?

Answer: B. Two mites, which make a farthing

And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing. (Mark 12:42, KJV)

Q4. What did Jesus say about the widow's gift compared to the rich?

Answer: B. She gave more than all the rich men, for she cast in all her living

Verily I say unto you, That this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury: For all they did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, even all her living. (Mark 12:43, KJV)

Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase. (Proverbs 3:9, KJV)

Q8. What did the master say to the faithful servant?

Answer: B. Well done, thou good and faithful servant

His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord. (Matthew 25:21, KJV)

Q9. What did Ananias and Sapphira do wrong?

Answer: B. They kept back part of the price, and lied to the Holy Ghost

But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? (Acts 5:3, KJV)

Q10. What does Hebrews 13:5 tell us to be without?

Answer: B. Covetousness; be content with such things as ye have

Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. (Hebrews 13:5, KJV)
