Q1. How did Jesus answer every temptation of Satan?

Answer: B. It is written — with Scripture

Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God... It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. (Matthew 4:7, KJV)

Q2. What did Satan tempt Jesus to do first?

Answer: A. Turn stones into bread

And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. (Matthew 4:3, KJV)

Q3. What does James 1:13 say about God and temptation?
