Q1. How much was Jesus betrayed for?

Answer: B. Thirty pieces of silver

And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver. (Matthew 26:15, KJV)

Q2. Where did Jesus pray before his arrest?

Answer: B. The Garden of Gethsemane

Then cometh Jesus with them unto a place called Gethsemane, and saith unto the disciples, Sit ye here, while I go and pray yonder. (Matthew 26:36, KJV)

Q3. What did Jesus pray in Gethsemane?

Answer: A. O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt

And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt. (Matthew 26:39, KJV)

Q4. Who carried Jesus' cross?

And as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name: him they compelled to bear his cross. (Matthew 27:32, KJV)

And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? (Matthew 27:46, KJV)

Q10. What did the centurion say?

Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God. (Matthew 27:54, KJV)
