**Q2.** What authority did Jesus declare He had?

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. (Matthew 28:18, KJV)

**Q3.** What was the command?

**Answer:** A. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. (Matthew 28:19, KJV)

**Q4.** In whose name were they to baptize?

**Q9.** Where, in Acts 1, were the disciples to be witnesses?
