## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1.** On what occasion did Jesus institute the Lord's Supper?

**Answer:** A. The Passover feast

And he sent Peter and John, saying, Go and prepare us the passover, that we may eat... And when the hour was come, he sat down, and the twelve apostles with him. (Luke 22:7, KJV)

**Q2.** What did Jesus take and bless, saying 'Take, eat; this is my body'?

**Answer:** B. The bread

And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body. (Matthew 26:26, KJV)

**Q3.** What did Jesus call the cup?

**Answer:** A. The blood of the covenant / the new testament in my blood

For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. (Matthew 26:28, KJV)

**Q4.** What did Jesus say He would not drink again until?

**Answer:** B. Until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom

But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom. (Matthew 26:29, KJV)

**Q5.** What did Paul say the bread represents?

**Answer:** A. The body of Christ

The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? (1 Corinthians 10:16, KJV)

**Q6.** What does the cup represent?

**Answer:** A. The blood of Christ

The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? (1 Corinthians 10:16, KJV)

**Q7.** What should a man do before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup?

**Answer:** B. Examine himself

But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. (1 Corinthians 11:28, KJV)

**Q8.** What happens to those who eat and drink unworthily?

**Answer:** B. They eat and drink damnation to themselves, not discerning the Lord's body

For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. (1 Corinthians 11:29, KJV)

**Q9.** What does the Lord's Supper proclaim?

**Answer:** B. The Lord's death till he come

For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come. (1 Corinthians 11:26, KJV)

**Q10.** In the upper room, what did Jesus do first to His disciples' feet?

**Answer:** A. Washed them

He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself. After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded. (John 13:4, KJV)
