## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1.** In what month was the Passover to begin Israel's year?

**Answer:** A. The first month

This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you. (Exodus 12:2, KJV)

**Q2.** On what day of the month was the lamb to be taken?

**Answer:** A. The tenth day

In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house. (Exodus 12:3, KJV)

**Q3.** What kind of lamb was required?

**Answer:** A. Without blemish, a male of the first year

Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats. (Exodus 12:5, KJV)

**Q4.** Where was the blood to be put?

**Answer:** A. On the two side posts and on the upper door post

And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it. (Exodus 12:7, KJV)

**Q5.** How was the flesh to be eaten?

**Answer:** A. Roast with fire, with unleavened bread and bitter herbs

And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it. (Exodus 12:8, KJV)

**Q6.** How were they to eat the Passover?

**Answer:** A. With loins girded, shoes on feet, staff in hand, in haste

And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD's passover. (Exodus 12:11, KJV)

**Q7.** What was the sign of the blood?

**Answer:** A. When I see the blood, I will pass over you

And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you. (Exodus 12:13, KJV)

**Q8.** How many days were unleavened bread to be eaten?

**Answer:** A. Seven days

Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses. (Exodus 12:15, KJV)

**Q9.** How does Paul describe Christ in 1 Corinthians 5?

**Answer:** A. Christ our passover is sacrificed for us

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump... For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us. (1 Corinthians 5:7, KJV)

**Q10.** What did Jesus say at the last supper, which was the Passover?

**Answer:** A. With desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer

And he said unto them, With desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer. (Luke 22:15, KJV)
