Q1. What does Psalm 86:15 say the LORD is full of?

But thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth. (Psalm 86:15) (Psalms 86:15, KJV)

Q2. What did Jesus feel when He saw the multitude?

Answer: A. He was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd

But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. (Matthew 9:36) (Matthew 9:36, KJV)

Q3. What does Colossians 3:12 say to put on as God's elect?

Answer: A. Bowels of mercies

Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering. (Colossians 3:12) (Colossians 3:12, KJV)

Q4. What does Matthew 5:7 say the merciful shall obtain?

Answer: A. Mercy

Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. (Matthew 5:7) (Matthew 5:7, KJV)

Q5. What does James 2:13 say judgment is to him that shewed no mercy?

Answer: A. Without mercy

For he shall have judgment without mercy, that hath shewed no mercy; and mercy rejoiceth against judgment. (James 2:13) (James 2:13, KJV)

Q6. What does Luke 6:36 say to be, as your Father is?

Answer: A. Merciful

Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful. (Luke 6:36) (Luke 6:36, KJV)

Q7. What does Zechariah 7:9 say to execute?

Answer: A. True judgment, and shew mercy and compassions every man to his brother

Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, Execute true judgment, and shew mercy and compassions every man to his brother. (Zechariah 7:9) (Zechariah 7:9, KJV)

Q8. What does Psalm 103:13 say the LORD pities them that fear him?

Answer: A. Like as a father pitieth his children

Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear him. (Psalm 103:13) (Psalms 103:13, KJV)

Q9. What does 1 Peter 3:8 say to be, having compassion one of another?

Answer: A. Of one mind

Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous. (1 Peter 3:8) (1 Peter 3:8, KJV)

Q10. What does Isaiah 49:13 say the LORD hath?

Answer: A. Compassion on his afflicted

For the LORD hath comforted his people, he will have mercy upon his afflicted. (Isaiah 49:13) (Isaiah 49:13, KJV)
