Answer: A. Content

I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content. (Philippians 4:11) (Philippians 4:11, KJV)

Q2. What does 1 Timothy 6:6 say is great gain?

Answer: B. Godliness with contentment

But godliness with contentment is great gain. (1 Timothy 6:6) (1 Timothy 6:6, KJV)

Q3. What did we bring into this world, and what can we carry out?

Answer: A. Nothing

For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. (1 Timothy 6:7) (1 Timothy 6:7, KJV)

Q4. What should be enough for us according to 1 Timothy 6:8?

Answer: A. Food and raiment

And having food and raiment let us be therewith content. (1 Timothy 6:8) (1 Timothy 6:8, KJV)

Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. (Hebrews 13:5) (Hebrews 13:5, KJV)

Answer: A. Cucumbers, melons, leeks, onions, and garlic

We remember the fish, which we did eat in Egypt freely; the cucumbers, and the melons, and the leeks, and the onions, and the garlick. (Numbers 11:5) (Numbers 11:5, KJV)

Answer: A. All things

I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me. (Philippians 4:13) (Philippians 4:13, KJV)

Q10. What does Proverbs 15:16 say is better than great treasure?

Answer: A. The fear of the LORD

Better is little with the fear of the LORD than great treasure and trouble therewith. (Proverbs 15:16) (Proverbs 15:16, KJV)
