**Q1. What did Moses tell Joshua before his death?**

**Answer:** A. Be strong and of a good courage

Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee. (Deuteronomy 31:6) (Deuteronomy 31:6, KJV)

**Q2. What did God say to Joshua repeatedly?**

**Answer:** A. Be strong and of a good courage

Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest. (Joshua 1:9) (Joshua 1:9, KJV)
