Q1. What is the Great Commission in Matthew 28:19-20?

Answer: A. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them... teaching them to observe all things

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. (Matthew 28:19-20) (Matthew 28:19, KJV)

Q2. What does Mark 16:15 say to preach?

Answer: A. The gospel to every creature

And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. (Mark 16:15) (Mark 16:15, KJV)

Q3. What does Romans 10:14-15 ask about hearing without a preacher?

Answer: A. How shall they hear without a preacher?

How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? (Romans 10:14) (Romans 10:14, KJV)

Q4. What does 2 Timothy 4:2 say to do with the word?

Answer: A. Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season

Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. (2 Timothy 4:2) (2 Timothy 4:2, KJV)

But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear. (1 Peter 3:15) (1 Peter 3:15, KJV)

Q7. What does 2 Corinthians 5:20 say we are?

Answer: A. Ambassadors for Christ

Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. (2 Corinthians 5:20) (2 Corinthians 5:20, KJV)

Q8. What does Matthew 5:16 say to let shine before men?

Answer: A. Your light, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. (Matthew 5:16) (Matthew 5:16, KJV)

Q9. What did Paul say he was not ashamed of in Romans 1:16?

Answer: A. The gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. (Romans 1:16) (Romans 1:16, KJV)

Q10. What does John 4:35 say about the fields?

Answer: A. They are white already to harvest

Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest. (John 4:35) (John 4:35, KJV)
