Q1. Complete: 'Now faith is the substance of things ____, the evidence of things not seen.'

Answer: A. hoped for

Hebrews 11:1 defines faith as the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. (Hebrews 11:1, KJV)

Q2. Without ____ it is impossible to please Him.

Answer: B. faith

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. (Hebrews 11:6, KJV)

Q3. Who is called the father of the faithful?

Answer: C. Abraham

Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness. Romans 4:3. (Romans 4:3, KJV)

Q4. What did Abraham do by faith when tested?

Answer: B. Offered up Isaac

By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac. (Hebrews 11:17, KJV)

Q5. How did Rahab show her faith?

Answer: D. All of the above

By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace. (Hebrews 11:31, KJV)
