Q1. How many times did Jesus say to forgive?

Answer: B. Seventy times seven

Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven. (Matthew 18:22, KJV)

Q2. In the Lord's Prayer, what do we ask God to forgive?

Answer: A. Our debts / trespasses

Forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. (Matthew 6:12, KJV)

Q3. What did the father of the prodigal do when he saw his son?

Answer: B. Ran, fell on his neck, and kissed him

When he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him. (Luke 15:20, KJV)

Q4. What did Jesus say from the cross?

Answer: A. Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do

Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. (Luke 23:34, KJV)

Q5. What must we do if our brother sins against us?
