**Q1.** What kind of friend is there that sticks closer than a brother?

**Answer:** A. A friend that loveth at all times

A man that hath friends must shew himself friendly: and there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother. (Proverbs 18:24) (Proverbs 18:24, KJV)

**Q2.** What does iron sharpening iron picture?

**Answer:** A. So a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend

Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend. (Proverbs 27:17) (Proverbs 27:17, KJV)

**Q3.** What are the wounds of a friend?

**Answer:** A. Faithful are the wounds of a friend

Faithful are the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy are deceitful. (Proverbs 27:6) (Proverbs 27:6, KJV)

**Q4.** Who was knit in soul to David?

**Answer:** A. Jonathan

And it came to pass... that the soul of Jonathan was knit with the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul. (1 Samuel 18:1) (1 Samuel 18:1, KJV)

**Q5.** What covenant did David and Jonathan make?

**Answer:** A. A covenant of friendship before the LORD

Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his own soul. (1 Samuel 18:3) (1 Samuel 18:3, KJV)

**Q6.** How did David describe his love for Jonathan after his death?

**Answer:** A. Thy love to me was wonderful, passing the love of women

I am distressed for thee, my brother Jonathan: very pleasant hast thou been unto me: thy love to me was wonderful, passing the love of women. (2 Samuel 1:26) (2 Samuel 1:26, KJV)

**Q7.** Whom did God call His friend in Isaiah?

**Answer:** A. Abraham

But thou, Israel, art my servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, the seed of Abraham my friend. (Isaiah 41:8) (Isaiah 41:8, KJV)

**Q8.** What greater love hath no man than this?

**Answer:** A. That a man lay down his life for his friends

Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. (John 15:13) (John 15:13, KJV)

**Q9.** Whom did Jesus call His friends?

**Answer:** A. Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you

Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. (John 15:14) (John 15:14, KJV)

**Q10.** What does James say a friend of the world is?

**Answer:** A. The enemy of God

Whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. (James 4:4) (James 4:4, KJV)
