Q1. What does 1 Thessalonians 5:18 say about giving thanks?

Answer: B. In every thing give thanks

In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. (1 Thessalonians 5:18) (1 Thessalonians 5:18, KJV)

Q2. What does Psalm 100 say we should enter His gates with?

Answer: B. Thanksgiving

Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. (Psalm 100:4) (Psalms 100:4, KJV)

Q3. How many of the ten lepers returned to give thanks to Jesus?

Answer: D. One

And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God. And Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? but where are the nine? (Luke 17:15-17) (Luke 17:15, KJV)

By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. (Hebrews 13:15) (Hebrews 13:15, KJV)

Q10. Who gave thanks before breaking the five loaves and two fishes?

Answer: B. Jesus

And he took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake them, and gave to his disciples. (Matthew 15:36) (Matthew 15:36, KJV)
