Q1. What does 1 Peter 1:15-16 say God calls us to be?

Answer: A. Holy in all manner of conversation

But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. (1 Peter 1:15-16) (1 Peter 1:15, KJV)

Q2. What did God command Israel in Leviticus 11:44?

Answer: A. Be holy; for I am holy

For I am the LORD your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I am holy. (Leviticus 11:44) (Leviticus 11:44, KJV)

Q3. What does Hebrews 12:14 say to follow after?

Answer: A. Holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord

Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord. (Hebrews 12:14) (Hebrews 12:14, KJV)

Q4. What does 2 Corinthians 7:1 call us to cleanse ourselves from?

Answer: A. All filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God

Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God. (2 Corinthians 7:1) (2 Corinthians 7:1, KJV)

Q5. What does Psalm 99:5 say about God's footstool?

Answer: A. He is holy

Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his footstool; for he is holy. (Psalm 99:5) (Psalms 99:5, KJV)

Q6. What does Isaiah 6:3 say the seraphim cry?

Answer: A. Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory

And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory. (Isaiah 6:3) (Isaiah 6:3, KJV)

Q7. What does Romans 12:1 say to present our bodies as?

Answer: A. A living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. (Romans 12:1) (Romans 12:1, KJV)

Q8. What does 1 Thessalonians 3:13 say God establish our hearts in?

Answer: A. Holiness

To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints. (1 Thessalonians 3:13) (1 Thessalonians 3:13, KJV)

Q9. What does Titus 2:14 say Christ gave Himself to purify?

Answer: A. A peculiar people, zealous of good works

Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. (Titus 2:14) (Titus 2:14, KJV)

Q10. What does Revelation 4:8 say the four living creatures cry?

Answer: A. Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come

And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come. (Revelation 4:8)
