Q1. What does Romans 5:5 say hope does not do?

Answer: A. Hope does not make ashamed

And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. (Romans 5:5, KJV)

Q2. What is described as 'an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast'?

Answer: B. Hope

Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil. (Hebrews 6:19, KJV)

Q3. What is the hope of the believer's calling, according to Ephesians 1:18?

Answer: A. The riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints. (Ephesians 1:18, KJV)

Q4. What does Romans 8:24-25 say we are saved by?

Answer: B. Hope

For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it. (Romans 8:24, KJV)

Q5. What does Psalm 39:7 say is the psalmist's hope?

And now, Lord, what wait I for? my hope is in thee. (Psalms 39:7, KJV)

Q6. What does Proverbs 13:12 say hope deferred does to the heart?

Hope deferred maketh the heart sick: but when the desire cometh, it is a tree of life. (Proverbs 13:12, KJV)

Q7. What does 1 Peter 1:3 say God has begotten us unto?

Answer: A. A living hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. (1 Peter 1:3, KJV)

Q8. What does Colossians 1:27 call the hope of glory?

Answer: A. Christ in you

To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. (Colossians 1:27, KJV)

Q9. What does Romans 12:12 tell us to rejoice in?

Answer: A. Hope

Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer. (Romans 12:12, KJV)

Q10. What does Jeremiah 29:11 say the LORD knows toward his people?

Answer: A. Thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. (Jeremiah 29:11, KJV)
