**Q1.** What does Nehemiah 8:10 say is our strength?

**Answer:** B. The joy of the LORD

For the joy of the LORD is your strength. (Nehemiah 8:10, KJV)

**Q2.** What does Psalm 16:11 say is in God's presence?

**Answer:** B. Fullness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore

Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore. (Psalms 16:11, KJV)

**Q3.** What does Psalm 30:5 say weeping may endure for?

**Answer:** B. A night, but joy cometh in the morning

For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning. (Psalms 30:5, KJV)

**Q4.** What did Jesus say to his disciples about their sorrow turning to joy?

**Answer:** A. Your sorrow shall be turned into joy

Verily, verily, I say unto you, That ye shall weep and lament, but the world shall rejoice: and ye shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy. (John 16:20, KJV)

**Q10.** What did David say about the man whose transgression is forgiven?

Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile. (Psalms 32:1, KJV)
