Q1. How is man justified according to Romans 3:28?

Answer: A. By faith without the deeds of the law

Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law. (Romans 3:28) (Romans 3:28, KJV)

Q2. What does Romans 5:1 say we have through justification by faith?

Answer: A. Peace with God

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 5:1) (Romans 5:1, KJV)

Q3. What did Abraham believe that was counted unto him for righteousness?

Answer: A. God, who quickeneth the dead

And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness. Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him; But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead. (Romans 4:22-24) (Romans 4:22, KJV)

Q4. What does Galatians 2:16 say no flesh is justified by?

Answer: A. The works of the law

Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ. (Galatians 2:16) (Galatians 2:16, KJV)

Q5. What does James 2:24 say a man is justified by?

Answer: A. Works, and not by faith only

Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only. (James 2:24) (James 2:24, KJV)

Q6. Whom did God justify according to Romans 8:33?

Answer: A. The elect

Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. (Romans 8:33) (Romans 8:33, KJV)

Q7. What does Isaiah 53:11 say the righteous servant shall justify?

Answer: A. Many

By his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities. (Isaiah 53:11) (Isaiah 53:11, KJV)

Q8. What are we justified freely by according to Romans 3:24?

Answer: A. His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus

Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus. (Romans 3:24) (Romans 3:24, KJV)

Q9. What did David describe in Psalm 32:1-2?

Answer: A. Blessedness of the man whose transgression is forgiven and sin is covered

Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity. (Psalm 32:1-2) (Psalms 32:1, KJV)

Answer: A. His grace, that we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life

That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. (Titus 3:7) (Titus 3:7, KJV)
