Q1. What is the first fruit of the Spirit?

Answer: C. Love / charity

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith. (Galatians 5:22, KJV)

Q2. Complete: 'God is ____'

Answer: C. love

He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. (1 John 4:8, KJV)

Q3. What did Jesus call the greatest commandment?

Answer: C. Both, with the first being greatest

Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. (Matthew 22:37, KJV)

Q4. What is the second commandment like unto it?

Answer: B. Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself

Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. (Matthew 22:39, KJV)

Q5. Complete: 'Charity suffereth ____, and is kind.'

Answer: A. long

Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up. (1 Corinthians 13:4, KJV)

Q6. What does charity not do?
