Q2. What does Paul tell fathers not to do?

Answer: A. Provoke not your children to wrath

And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. (Ephesians 6:4) (Ephesians 6:4, KJV)

Q3. What are children to do?

Answer: A. Obey your parents in the Lord

Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. (Ephesians 6:1) (Ephesians 6:1, KJV)

Q4. What is the first commandment with promise?

Answer: A. Honour thy father and mother

Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth. (Ephesians 6:2-3) (Ephesians 6:2, KJV)

Q5. What are children called in Psalm 127?

Answer: A. An heritage of the LORD

Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward. (Psalm 127:3) (Psalms 127:3, KJV)

Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him. (Proverbs 22:15) (Proverbs 22:15, KJV)

And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children. (Deuteronomy 6:6-7) (Deuteronomy 6:7, KJV)

Q8. From whom did Timothy learn the holy scriptures as a child?

Answer: A. His grandmother Lois and his mother Eunice

When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice. (2 Timothy 1:5) (2 Timothy 1:5, KJV)

Q9. How long had Timothy known the scriptures?

Answer: A. From a child

And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 3:15) (2 Timothy 3:15, KJV)

But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven.
(Matthew 19:14) (Matthew 19:14, KJV)
