Q1. What does James 1:4 say patience works?

Answer: A. That ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing

But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing. (James 1:4) (James 1:4, KJV)

Q2. What does Romans 5:3-4 say tribulation works?

Answer: A. Patience; and patience, experience; and experience, hope

And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; And patience, experience; and experience, hope. (Romans 5:3-4) (Romans 5:3, KJV)

Q3. What does Ecclesiastes 7:8 say about the patient in spirit?

Answer: A. Better is the patient in spirit than the proud in spirit

Better is the end of a thing than the beginning thereof: and the patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit. (Ecclesiastes 7:8) (Ecclesiastes 7:8, KJV)

Q4. What does Psalm 37:7 tell us to do?

And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. (Galatians 6:9) (Galatians 6:9, KJV)

That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises. (Hebrews 6:12) (Hebrews 6:12, KJV)

Q8. What does James 5:7-8 compare the farmer to?

Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. (James 5:7) (James 5:7, KJV)

Q9. What does 2 Peter 3:9 say the Lord is not slack about?

Answer: A. His promise, but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish

The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. (2 Peter 3:9) (2 Peter 3:9, KJV)

Q10. What does Proverbs 14:29 say about him that is slow to wrath?

Answer: A. Of great understanding

He that is slow to wrath is of great understanding: but he that is hasty of spirit exalteth folly. (Proverbs 14:29)
