Q1. Who is called the Prince of Peace?

Answer: C. Jesus Christ

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6, KJV)

Q2. What kind of peace did Jesus leave with his disciples?

Answer: B. His own peace, not as the world giveth

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. (John 14:27, KJV)

Q3. What does Romans 5:1 say we have with God through Jesus Christ?

Answer: B. Peace

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 5:1, KJV)

Q4. What does Philippians 4:7 say the peace of God does?

Answer: A. Passeth all understanding, and keepeth hearts and minds through Christ Jesus

And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:7, KJV)
