Q3. What does Hebrews 12:1 tell us to lay aside?

Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us. (Hebrews 12:1) (Hebrews 12:1, KJV)
