Jesus... departed into a mountain to pray. (Mark 6:46, KJV)

Q2. How did Jesus begin the Lord's Prayer?

Answer: B. Our Father which art in heaven

Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. (Matthew 6:9, KJV)

Q3. What does Jesus tell us to pray for first?

Answer: B. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done

Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. (Matthew 6:10, KJV)

Q4. Where did Daniel pray three times a day?

Answer: B. In his house, with his windows open toward Jerusalem

He kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime. (Daniel 6:10, KJV)
