## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1. What does Romans 5:10 say we were reconciled to God by?**

**Answer:** A. The death of his Son, being enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son

For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life. (Romans 5:10) (Romans 5:10, KJV)

**Q2. What has God given us according to 2 Corinthians 5:18-19?**

**Answer:** A. The ministry of reconciliation, as God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself

And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. (2 Corinthians 5:18-19) (2 Corinthians 5:18, KJV)

**Q3. What does Colossians 1:21-22 say we were alienated from?**

**Answer:** A. Enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled in the body of his flesh through death

And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreprieveable in his sight. (Colossians 1:21-22) (Colossians 1:21, KJV)

**Q4. What does Ephesians 2:16 say Christ reconciled to God?**

**Answer:** A. Both Jew and Gentile in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby

And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby. (Ephesians 2:16) (Ephesians 2:16, KJV)

**Q5. What does Matthew 5:24 say to do before offering a gift at the altar?**

**Answer:** A. First be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift

Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift. (Matthew 5:24) (Matthew 5:24, KJV)

**Q6. What does 1 Peter 3:8 say to be, having compassion one of another?**

**Answer:** A. Of one mind

Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous. (1 Peter 3:8) (1 Peter 3:8, KJV)

**Q7. What does Hebrews 2:17 say Jesus was made like His brethren for?**

**Answer:** A. To be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people

Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. (Hebrews 2:17) (Hebrews 2:17, KJV)

**Q8. What does Isaiah 59:2 say our iniquities have done?**

**Answer:** A. Separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you

But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. (Isaiah 59:2) (Isaiah 59:2, KJV)

**Q9.** What does James 4:4 say friendship with the world is?

**Answer:** A. Enmity with God

Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. (James 4:4) (James 4:4, KJV)

**Q10.** What does Romans 5:11 say we joy in?

**Answer:** A. God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement

And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement. (Romans 5:11) (Romans 5:11, KJV)
