Q1. What does Jesus pray for His disciples in John 17:17?

Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. (John 17:17) (John 17:17, KJV)

Q2. What is God's will according to 1 Thessalonians 4:3?

Answer: A. Even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication

For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication. (1 Thessalonians 4:3) (1 Thessalonians 4:3, KJV)

Q3. How are believers sanctified according to Hebrews 10:10?

Answer: A. By the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all

By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. (Hebrews 10:10) (Hebrews 10:10, KJV)

Q4. What are Christians called in 1 Corinthians 1:2?

Answer: A. The church of God which is at Corinth, sanctified in Christ Jesus

Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints. (1 Corinthians 1:2) (1 Corinthians 1:2, KJV)

Q5. What does Romans 6:19 say about presenting our members?

Answer: A. As servants to righteousness unto holiness

I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness. (Romans 6:19) (Romans 6:19, KJV)

Q6. What does Hebrews 12:14 tell us to follow after?

Answer: A. Holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord

Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord. (Hebrews 12:14) (Hebrews 12:14, KJV)

Q7. According to 2 Corinthians 7:1, what should we cleanse ourselves from?

Answer: A. All filthiness of the flesh and spirit

Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God. (2 Corinthians 7:1) (2 Corinthians 7:1, KJV)

Q8. What does 1 Peter 1:15-16 call believers to be?

Answer: A. Holy in all manner of conversation

But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. (1 Peter 1:15-16) (1 Peter 1:15, KJV)

Q9. By what are we saved and sanctified according to 1 Corinthians 6:11?

Answer: A. In the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God

And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. (1 Corinthians 6:11) (1 Corinthians 6:11, KJV)

Q10. What is the purpose of Christ's sacrifice according to Ephesians 5:25-27?

Answer: A. That He might sanctify and cleanse the church, to present it holy and without blemish

Christ loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. (Ephesians 5:25-27) (Ephesians 5:26, KJV)
