Q1. Where did Jesus tell us to pray?

Answer: A. Enter into thy closet... shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret

But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret. (Matthew 6:6) (Matthew 6:6, KJV)

Q2. What did Joshua command about the book of the law?

Answer: A. Meditate therein day and night

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night. (Joshua 1:8) (Joshua 1:8, KJV)

Q3. What did the blessed man delight in?

Answer: A. The law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night

But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. (Psalm 1:2) (Psalms 1:2, KJV)

Q4. How often did Daniel pray?

Answer: A. Three times a day

He kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime. (Daniel 6:10) (Daniel 6:10, KJV)

Q5. When did Jesus rise to pray in Mark 1?

Answer: A. A great while before day

And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed. (Mark 1:35) (Mark 1:35, KJV)

Q6. What did Jesus say about fasting?

Answer: A. When thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face

But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face. (Matthew 6:17) (Matthew 6:17, KJV)

Q7. How long did Jesus fast in the wilderness?

Answer: A. Forty days and forty nights

And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred. (Matthew 4:2) (Matthew 4:2, KJV)

Q8. What does Paul tell us to do without ceasing?

Answer: A. Pray without ceasing

Pray without ceasing. (1 Thessalonians 5:17) (1 Thessalonians 5:17, KJV)

Q9. What hid the psalmist in his heart that he might not sin?

Answer: A. Thy word

Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. (Psalm 119:11) (Psalms 119:11, KJV)

Q10. How did the Bereans search the scriptures?

Answer: A. Daily, whether those things were so

These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so. (Acts 17:11) (Acts 17:11, KJV)
