### Q1. What is required in stewards?

**Answer:** A. That a man be found faithful

Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful. (1 Corinthians 4:2) (1 Corinthians 4:2, KJV)

### Q2. What does the parable of the talents teach?

**Answer:** A. To him that hath shall be given, and from him that hath not shall be taken away

For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath. (Matthew 25:29) (Matthew 25:29, KJV)

### Q3. What did the unfaithful servant do with his talent?

**Answer:** A. He hid it in the earth

And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine. (Matthew 25:25) (Matthew 25:25, KJV)

### Q4. What does Paul say about giving?

**Answer:** A. God loveth a cheerful giver

Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. (2 Corinthians 9:7) (2 Corinthians 9:7, KJV)

### Q5. What does Proverbs say about honoring the LORD with our substance?
